

Arc Flash Safety

NFPA 70E

To protect operators NFPA 70E standards require a "Flash Protection Boundary." Only qualified personnel with extensive protective clothing and equipment, including fire-resistant suits and hoods along with non-conductive wands, can access electrical equipment enclosures capable of generating an arc flash.
